

ASC REGISTRATION

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Obtain a course name and course reference number (CRN) from your high school instructor. You must be currently enrolled in the course to register.
2. Create a student profile if new, or log-in if returning, to the ASC online registration portal, ideal-Logic (shown below).
3. Complete the online registration form and select the class(es) you are taking.
4. For full or partial balances, payment should be made at the time of registration. Applicable scholarships will be paid by a third party at a later date.

If you have not logged into the Ideal-Logic account before, you will be prompted to create an account. If you have already applied to a Youth Programs activity, use your previously created details and log-in. Follow the prompts to complete.

REGISTRATION DETAILS

- Tuition is \$56 per credit or \$224 for a typical 4-credit course. A maximum of 20 credits is allowed per term.
- Course name, course reference number (CRN), and course information is available from your instructor, the ASC website, and the online registration form under Sections tab. If you select a class that has a lab, you must also select that lab from the Labs tab.
- We will register you in our system after we receive your submitted registration form and full payment (or scholarship confirmation).
- Please note that there is no retroactive registration. You may only register for a class within the term that it is offered. Once a registration term deadline has passed, SOU cannot retroactively register you for credit.
- If you have a partial or full scholarship from your school or other organization, you will select Scholarship in the Payment tab and name that organization so we know whom to contact for payment. The scholarship organization must pay at the full rate, not at the waiver rate. For partial scholarships, once we confirm your scholarship, we will follow up with you to request payment of any remaining balance due.
- Most ASC courses are offered in two 4-credit sections. This means you will register and pay for credit twice during the school year. Please check with your high school instructor to find out more and adhere to the deadlines.
